

Early Talk Boost

An interactive and practical course, developing knowledge, ideas and strategies to support children with language delay.

Early Talk Boost is a targeted intervention aimed at 3-4 year old children with delayed language development helping to boost their language skills and narrow the gap between them and their peers.

Children make an average of 6 months progress after a nine week intervention helping them to catch up with other children their age.

The **Course Aims** to enable participants better support and improve children's outcomes by training participants to run language intervention groups for young children with language delay.

After attending participants will be able to:

- Understand the rationale behind *Early Talk Boost*.
- Understand aspects of early language development.
- Identify appropriate children for the intervention.
- Deliver the intervention.
- Measure children's progress.
