

Talk Boost

An interactive and practical course, developing knowledge, ideas and strategies to support children with language delay.

Talk Boost is a targeted and evidence-based intervention programme, which supports language delayed children in Reception and Key Stage One (KS1) to make progress with their language and communication skills.

Children make an average of 18 months progress following the 10 week intervention. Our director, Wendy Lee authored Talk Boost whilst working at the Communication Trust.

The **Course Aims** to enable participants better support and improve children's outcomes by training participants to run language intervention groups for young children with language delay.

After attending participants will be able to:

- Understand the rationale behind *Talk Boost*.
- Understand aspects of language development.
- Identify appropriate children for the intervention.
- Deliver the intervention.
- Measure children's progress.
